

# The Latymer School-Year 9 Option Form

The key stage 4 curriculum at Latymer consists of these subjects: English Language and Literature (taught as English); Mathematics; Triple Award Science (taught as Chemistry, Physics and Biology); a modern foreign language; and a humanity subject (humanity subjects are History, Geography and RE). Students then choose 2 other subjects and this makes 10 GCSE subjects. In addition all students also study non-examination PE and RE (with citizenship).

It is best to aim for a curriculum which provides the opportunity to give a breadth in terms of knowledge and balance in terms of skills.

To complete this form you must

- **choose one** subject from box 1. Indicate your choice with a tick (✓) next to the subject
- **choose one** subject from box 2. Indicate your choice with a tick (✓) next to the subject
- **choose two** subjects from box 3. Indicate your choices by placing a '1' next to your first choice subject and a '2' next to your second choice subject. We will try to give everyone their first two choices from box 3. However, this may not always be possible. To help, place a '3' next to your third choice subject and a '4' next to your fourth choice subject
