UNIFORM LIST

Sixth form do not wear uniform.

Both sixth formers and members of year groups required to wear uniform (Years 7 – 11) should dress whilst at school in a way that is fit for a place of work, that enables them to engage fully in the curriculum, and that provides no undue risk to their health and safety.

GIRLS' UNIFORM: YEARS 7-11

SKIRT	Plain navy kilt or box-pleat style available from Lyons: should not be more than 3 inches above the bottom of the knee.
SHOES/BOOTS	Plain black leather or imitation leather. Light weight boots are permitted in combination with trousers but not with skirts. Heavy working or walking boots are not permitted. Except for the underneath of the sole all parts of the shoe/boot must be entirely black and have a maximum heel height of 2". Steel-tipped or narrow heels are not allowed as these damage the wooden floors.
TIGHTS	Black, grey, or navy: plain, single colour.
SOCKS	Black, grey, or navy: plain, single colour: below knee length.
SHIRT	Plain white school shirt as obtainable at Lyons, with regular collar. Long or short sleeves are permitted. Underwear should not be of a colour that shows through the shirt.
TIE	Latymer tie available at Lyons or Smiths
JUMPER	Plain navy, v-neck. No other jumper or sweat shirt is permitted.
RIBBONS/SLIDES	Navy or black. Metal slides are allowed
JEWELLERY	Pupils whose ears have been pierced may wear plain and unobtrusive gold or silver ear studs or sleepers up to a maximum of two per ear. No other jewellery is allowed below the sixth form.
TROUSERS	Optional plain navy (full length, straight cut), available from Lyons and Smiths. Other styles are not permitted.
LABORATORY OVERALL	Royal blue (only available direct from Alexandra Workwear Ltd. Order forms are supplied by the school).
BLAZER	Optional. If worn must be plain navy with the school badge.
MAKE-UP	No make-up or coloured nail varnish is permitted
OUTDOOR UNIFORM	
FOOTWEAR	The uniform shoes should be worn on the way to and from school. Trainers must not be worn on the journey to and from school.
COATS	There is no restriction on the outdoor coat. We advise against the wearing of expensive coats or jackets as the school is not insured for the loss of a pupil's property. Coats may not be worn or carried around school but should be stored either in cloakrooms or in bags.

BOYS' UNIFORM, YEARS 7 – 11

BLAZER	Navy, with School Badge.
SHOES/BOOTS	Black leather or imitation leather. Light-weight boots are permitted. Heavy working or walking boots are not permitted. Except for the underneath of the sole all parts of the shoe/boot must be entirely black.
SOCKS	Black, grey, or navy : plain, single colour.
TROUSERS	Plain charcoal grey. 'Classic' style as available at school outfitters.
TIE	School tie.
SHIRT	Plain white with a regular collar of traditional style as available at school outfitters. Long or short sleeves are permitted. Underwear should not be of a colour that shows through the shirt.
PULLOVER	Plain navy, V-neck. No other jumper or sweat shirt is permitted.
LABORATORY OVERALL	Royal blue (only available direct from Alexandra Workwear Limited, order forms are supplied by the school).
JEWELLERY	Pupils whose ears have been pierced may wear plain and unobtrusive gold or silver studs or sleepers up to a maximum of two per ear. No other jewellery is allowed.
OUTDOOR UNIFORM	
FOOTWEAR	The uniform shoes/boots should be worn on the way to and from school. Trainers must not be worn on the journey to and from school.
COATS	There is no restriction on the outdoor coat. We advise against the wearing of expensive coats or jackets as the school is not insured for the loss of a pupil's property. Coats may not be worn or carried around the school but should be stored either in cloakrooms or in bags
